

## Minutes of the December 2010 General Meeting, Arizona Chapter MOAA

The holiday luncheon meeting of the General Membership was held on December 18, 2010, at the McCormick Ranch Golf Club. President Ron Perkins called the meeting to order at 11:55 AM and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by an invocation.

Jim will continue in those roles along with the additional job as 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President next year.
